

## PREFACE

This issue, No. 99 in the series of “Israel Government Publications” and the last one to appear in print, includes a bibliographical list of publications of government ministries and state corporations received by the Israel State Archives during 2006.

The wide range of interests reflected in the publications of each body provides an up-to-date picture of some of the major issues facing Israeli society and influencing decision makers. As before, the publications are available for researchers and to the public and make a solid starting point for research in many fields of interest.

Publications are arranged by codes given to government offices or other bodies, and within each body according to a number given when received at the Archives, and then by divisions and departments. The hierarchy as found in the list does not confirm completely with the administrative structure since some modification has been made to adapt it to the bibliographical list.

As a result of the continuous growth in web communication, more and more publications appear only on the web. Those publications can be found via the Israel government portal: [www.gov.il](http://www.gov.il) The Israel State Archives, together with other government ministries, is preparing to adapt itself to recent developments and is making arrangements for collecting, saving and cataloging digital publications in addition to the traditional paper ones.

The bibliographical items in this issue, as well as those in the previous ones, can be found on the Israel State Archives website: [www.archives.gov.il](http://www.archives.gov.il) As a result of these technological developments, this issue, as stated, will be the last one in print. The next bibliographical list (for 2007), will appear on the website only.

All publications in Latin script are entered in the English section. Bilingual publications are entered in both sections.

There are two indexes in both languages: a subject index and an author index. The English indexes relate to the publications in the English section only.
